### Principal's Report:

- Budget Update
  - Playworks is being used to improve school climate. The coach this year is very engaged with the school and students. Good feedback was provided by the teachers in attendance.
  - Student Transformation Team stipend
  - Paraprofessionals are used in lower grades to provide literacy support, freeing up teachers to do intensive work with students below benchmark. This is a multi-year project and will take time to see impact on results.

- Student Success Plan
  - Reviewed Student Success Plan and three year priorities.
  - DIEBELS shows high number of students below or well below benchmark. Data was missing for some classes.
  - District goals are also Whittier goals.
